Trails Rules and Regulations

Hours: Sunrise to Sunset

- Trails are owned and maintained by the Winsome Metropolitan District.
- Motorized vehicles, gas and/or electric, are expressly prohibited.
- Cyclists yield to pedestrians. Pedestrians and cyclists yield to horses.
- Equestrians shall scatter horse manure off parking and/or trail areas.
- Bicyclists are to keep speeds leisurely while maintaining a safe distance from other trail users and utilize single file passing to maintain control and avoid trail erosion.
- Remain on the trail. No off-trail hiking or riding at any time to protect vegetation and minimize erosion.
- Pets must be leashed, and no animal may be running at large.
- Pet waste must be disposed of immediately and completely.
- Disposal of all litter, trash, and debris is mandatory.
- Do not disturb wildlife. It is unlawful for any unauthorized person to hunt, molest, harm, frighten, kill, trap, chase, tease, shoot, feed or throw missiles at any animal.
- Hunting and firearms are prohibited.
- No personal music or amplified sound devices.
- No alcohol, drugs, smoking, vaping, or glass containers.
- Respect other users, neighbors, and facilities.
- Vandalism will be prosecuted.
